**HARLAN FAMILY TOUR OF
ENGLAND & NORTHERN IRELAND**

April 26-May 5, 2018

ITINERARY

Day 1 - Thursday, April 26: Arrive Manchester

Upon arrival in Manchester we will be met by our local tour manager and driver. Once all of our group members have arrived on their respective flights, we will transfer to our local hotel for check-in. A welcome reception will be followed by dinner and a talk about what's to come on our trip. (D)

Day 2 - Friday, April 27: Manchester / York

After a leisurely breakfast, we will check out from our hotel and drive north to Harewood House which was built between 1759 and 1771 for the wealthy plantation owner Edwin Lascelles. Enjoy a guided tour of the house and gardens before continuing our drive to York. Upon arrival in York we will have a guided tour of the Cathedral and Metropolitan Church of Saint Peter in York, commonly known as York Minster, which is one of the most beautiful cathedrals in Europe. Then proceed to our hotel for check-in. (B/D)



Day 3 - Saturday, April 28: York

After breakfast, we will drive to Sutton Park, the site of the Harland House pictured in Alpheus Harlan's book (page 968). After a visit to the house and gardens and time for coffee in the café, we will cross the road to visit All Hallows Church which contains the remains and memorial plaques of several generations of Harlands from Sutton Hall. We then return to York. The remainder of the day will be free to explore the walled city of York on our own with time for shopping and visiting with the cousins and exchanging stories. Dinner tonight is on our own. (B)

Day 4 - Sunday, April 29: York

After breakfast this morning, we will drive north to the seaside town of Monkwearmouth to attend Sunday Eucharist at St. Peter's Church in which George Harlan was baptized in 1660. After Sunday services we will enjoy

guided tour of the church which is now a World Heritage Site. Then drive to Fountains Abbey which is one of the largest and best preserved ruined Cistercian monasteries in England. After visiting the Abbey ruins and the gardens we will return to York for overnight. (B/D)



Day 5 - Monday, April 30: York / Chester

After breakfast we will depart York and drive to Chester which was founded as a Roman fortress in the 1st century A.D. and is known for its extensive Roman walls made of local red sandstone. Upon arrival in Chester we will check-in at our hotel and then have the remainder of the afternoon on our own for shopping and to explore the city including its Cathedral and ancient walls. (B/D)

Day 6 - Tuesday, May 1: Chester / Conwy / Chester

Today we will drive along the northern coast of Wales to the walled market town Conwy where there will be time to explore the Castle and historic town center. In the afternoon we return to Chester for dinner and overnight in our hotel. (B/D)



Day 7 - Wednesday, May 2: Chester / Liverpool / Belfast

After an early breakfast, we will drive to Liverpool airport to catch our flight to Belfast. Belfast is essentially a Victorian city and no matter where you go you can see Edwardian and Victorian buildings with elaborate sculptures over the windows and doors. Enjoy a tour of

the city including the City Hall which dominates the main shopping area, St. Anne's Cathedral, the historic Belfast Port and Harbour which was once the UK's largest shipyard and the Titanic Center. We will then proceed to our hotel for check-in. (B/D)



Day 8 - Thursday, May 3: Belfast / Lurgan / Armagh / Belfast
After breakfast, we will drive to Lurgan to visit the new Friends Meeting House which was built a few years ago to replace the old Meeting House built in 1696. We will meet with some members who will tell us something about the history of the Friends in Ireland and our ancestors, followed by lunch prepared by the members. We will then proceed to Armagh which is one of Ireland's oldest cities and has been its spiritual capital for over 1,500 years. Visit the Cathedral of St. Patrick and then take a tour of the historic center of the city. Return to Belfast for overnight. This evening we will have a festive dinner at a local restaurant. (B/D)



Day 9 - Friday, May 4: Belfast / Giant's Causeway / Belfast
After breakfast we will travel north to visit Northern Ireland's most famous landmark, the Giant's Causeway. This remarkable natural wonder where over 37,000 basalt columns extend from the cliffs and into the sea was once believed to be the work of the giants, hence its name. No matter how many times visitors have seen this, the sheer wonder and magic of the columns never fail to impress! We will then drive along the Antrim Coast as we return to Belfast. Dinner tonight is on our own. (B)



Day 10 - Saturday, May 5: Depart Belfast

After breakfast we transfer as a group to the airport to catch our return flights home or to continue on to other destinations on our own. (B)

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Travel Documents: A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U. S. citizens. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to the countries being visited on this tour. If you are not a U. S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. George's International is not responsible for visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: International airfare to Manchester and return from Belfast is NOT included in the package price. Airfare in economy class is included only for the flight segment from Liverpool to Belfast on May 2, 2018. Airfare for the flight from Liverpool to Belfast is based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares/flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.

Arrival and Departure Transfers: Transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa on the arrival and departure days is included in the package price based upon one pickup time and one drop-off time for the entire group. If you are arriving or departing at times that are much different than the rest of the group members than you will be responsible for your own transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.
